## **Diversity**

The most recent student diversity numbers were reported for the fall semester 2021. Female students comprised 41.5% of the student body. Male students comprised 58.5% of the student body.

Ethnic groups were self-reported with the following results:

American Indian/Alaskan 1.8%  
Asian 4.6%  
African American/Black 6.5%  
Hispanic 8.4%  
Native Hawaiian/Pacific Islander .9%  
Two or More Races 3.7%  
White 71.3%  
Non-resident alien 2.8%.

*For the 2019-2020 academic year, for the first time/full time students, 75% of students received a Pell Grant.*

## **Retention**

The most recent retention rates show a full-time retention rate of 66.6% for first-time full-time freshmen entering in the Fall of 2021 returning Fall 2022.

## **Completion**

Based on the experience of the first-time full-time degree seeking freshman classes who began their studies in 2014, using a completion standard involving a time frame of 150 percent of published time, the 2014 completion rate is 37%. Percentage of Full-time, First-time Students Who Graduated in the Specified Amount of Time and Began in Fall 2012 or Fall 2014. seeking a 4-year bachelors degree, was 25%.

## **Placement**

Bachelor's degree recipients in the classes of 2012-2018 **indicated** the following plans postgraduation:

36% Enter or remain in paid ministry positions  
26% Pursue a further degree outside/beyond CCCB (Seminary, University, etc.)  
10 % Plan to enter the mission field  
23% Work and serve as a volunteer in ministry/work alongside of spouse

Bachelor's degree recipients in the class of 2022 indicated the following plans postgraduation:

20% Enter or remain in paid ministry positions  
36% Pursue a further degree outside/beyond CCCB (Seminary, University, etc.)  
4% Plan to enter the mission field  
40% Work and serve as a volunteer in ministry/work alongside of spouse
