

**Higher Education Emergency Relief Fund III  
Supplemental Support under the American Rescue Plan (SSARP)  
Report as of 9/30/2022**

The Higher Education Emergency Relief Fund (HEERF III) was authorized by the American Rescue Plan (ARP), Public Law 117-2, and signed into law on March 11, 2022. It provides \$39.6 billion in support to institutions of higher education to serve students and ensure learning continues during the COVID-19 pandemic. In 2022 the Department authorized additional support under the American rescue Plan. Central Christian College of the Bible signed and agreed to the Certification and Agreements provided by the Department of Education (DOE) for both programs with the assurance that the institution would use the funds to provide Emergency Financial Aid Grants to Students. All of these funds will be used in accordance with the agreement to provide Emergency Financial Aid Grants to students.

The \$373,376 was made available to the college on May 18, 2021, and the first distribution to students was made on December 3, 2021. A second disbursement was made on January 28, 2022. Central had 176 students enrolled during the Fall 2021 semester, and 185 enrolled during the Spring 2022 semester. There have been 328 enrolled since the beginning of the pandemic. 54 of those students applied for assistance in the first round of applications. The second round included disbursements for an additional 57 students, as well as some additional disbursements for prior recipients. All of the students that applied received assistance. As of 3/31/2022, \$373,376 (all of the original funds) had been distributed to 111 students. On July 19, 2022, Central received an additional \$33,334 from the SSARP program funds to distribute as emergency student aid grants to students. None of those funds were distributed as of September 30, 2022.
