Diversity

The most recent student diversity numbers were reported in 2014-15. Female students comprised 48.9% of the student body. Male students comprised 51.1% of the student body. Ethnic groups were self-reported with the following results: Native American/Alaskan, 1.0%; Asian, 1.5%; Multiple, 2.2%; Hispanic, 2.6%; Black, 3.7%; White, 88.8%. There were no students reporting Unknown ethnicities.

Retention

The most recent retention rates calculated from IPEDS show a *full-time retention rate of 77%* for first-time freshmen entering in the Fall of 2013.

Completion

Based upon the experience of the first-time, full-time degree-seeking freshman classes from 2006-2008, using a completion standard involving a time frame of 150 percent of published time (a four-year program taking no more than six years), *the 2006-2008 completion rate is 40%*.

Central has reported to the National Center for Education Statistics *the completion rate of 42% for the Fall 2008 cohort*.

Placement

Bachelor's degree recipients in the classes of 2008-2015 indicated the following plans post-graduation:

- 36% Enter or remain in paid ministry positions (sr. minister, youth minister, etc.)
- 24% Pursue a further degree outside/beyond CCCB (Seminary, University, etc.)
- 14% Plan to enter the mission field
- 22% Work and serve as a volunteer in ministry/work alongside of spouse
