



## Off-to-College Checklist

Use this checklist to make sure you have everything you need for your first year at CCCB. These are just suggestions; you should adapt this list to suit your own situation.

To save packing or shipping, it might make sense to buy some of these items after you arrive. It might also make sense to pack for one season at a time and switch items when you go home during breaks.

### Room Needs

- Bedside / Desk lamp
- Alarm clock/clock radio
- Small trash can

- Sheets and pillowcases (2 sets. Extra long twin)

- Laptop (printer is optional; there are computer labs where you can print)
- Portable speakers (if you want to play music from laptop/MP3 player)
- Surge protector
